### THE JOHNSTONES OF ELPHINSTONE

AST LOTHIAN, a rich county in the Middle Ages, held many religious houses of secondary importance, but no abbey of the first rank. In the same way it supported a large number of smaller landed families but no great family to compare with such as the Hamiltons or Argylls. At its eastern end, where the hills came close to the shore and the battle of Pinkie, Carberry Hill, and Prestonpans were fought, rich well-drained soil and the presence of workable coal seams near the surface, permitted the rise of a greater number of moneyed families than might have been expected within so small a district. From the time of Bruce the Setons held predominance in this area. South of the Seton lands were those of Elphinstone, represented today by the three farms of Elphinstone Tower, North and South Elphinstone. In the middle of the thirteenth century these lands were held by John de Elphinstone. His descendant, William de Elphinstone, died in 1426, leaving three sons, Alexander, Henry, and William. The last mentioned entered the priesthood, became Archdeacon of Teviotdale and the father of William Elphinstone, Bishop of Aberdeen. Alexander, the eldest, died at Piperdean on 10 September 1435, leaving an infant daughter, Agnes, who may have been a posthumous child. His younger brother, Henry, took possession of the family lands and after long legal proceedings he was obliged in 1476 to surrender to his niece the lands of Elphinstone, Leuchie at North Berwick, and Nether Malgask in Fife; he was allowed to retain the Elphinstone lands at Airth, and from him the modern family of Elphinstone is descended.

Agnes Elphinstone, about 1460, married Gilbert Johnstone, the eldest son of a marriage between Adam Johnstone of Annandale and Janet, widow of William, Master of Seton, and through the influence of her mother's powerful family she was in possession of the Elphinstone lands in East Lothian some years before the decision in her favour. Thus we find here that a lesser landed family originates, quite characteristically, in the marriage of the younger son of a greater house with an heiress. Knighted before 1472, Gilbert Johnstone was Sheriff of Edinburgh from 1484 to 1486 and died between 1493 and 1497.

Adam Johnstone of Elphinstone, his eldest son, must have been born in the fourteen-sixties. He married Agnes Hog, succeeded his father before 1497, was knighted between 1503 and 1506, sat in parliament in 1528, and died between 1532 and 31 October 1534.

Andrew, his second son, the third Johnstone laird of Elphinstone, succeeded his father, since Gilbert, the eldest son, had died at Flodden, and with him the family history becomes something more than a brief record of names and formal entries. Like so many of the lairds of East Lothian in the early sixteenth century he welcomed Protestantism and lent support, sometimes open and sometimes covert, to Henry VIII. In 1544 he was in frequent communication with the Regent Arran. Returning south from the invasion of that year Hertford passed along the north of the lands of Elphinstone. Seton was among the many Scottish castles which he burned but Elphinstone, most suspiciously, was left untouched, as were also the Protestant homes of Ormiston and Longniddry. When George Wishart was arrested at Ormiston in January 1546, Cardinal Beaton confronted him in the hall of Elphinstone Tower. Knox, who was deeply committed to Wishart and intimately acquainted with the Johnstones of Elphinstone, did not see fit to record the exact role of the family in these events. Andrew Johnstone gave various services to the state, and among other things acted as Warden of the Middle Marches. Ultimately he abandoned the party of the Queen Regent to appear among the throng of lesser barons who claimed a place in the parliament of 1560. On 27 April he and his heir had signed "ane contract of the Lords and Barons to defend the Liberty of the Evangell of Christ," thus acknowledging openly the Protestantism which they had long held. This was among the last acts of Andrew Johnstone, for by 25 October 1561, he was dead. By his wife, Mariota or Margaret Douglas of Corhead, he had nine children, James, John, Adam, Robert, Gilbert, Agnes, Janet, Mariota, and Elizabeth.

James, the eldest son, succeeded his father in the lands of Elphinstone. On 24 March 1550 he married as his first wife, Margaret, eleventh child of William, Master of Ruthven, and a descendant of Thor of Tranent, the twelfth century superior of Elphinstone. She died soon after the marriage and on 25 March 1564 he married Janet, eleventh child of Sir James Melville of Halhill.

Openly committed to the Protestant party, Johnstone soon found himself in trouble. In 1564 he was "at the horn" and, for a time, his lands were confiscated. In 1566 he was one of the group who burst into the Queen's apartments and murdered Rizzio, although his nephew, Hume of Godscroft, passes over his uncle's part in the affair. Randolph, on 21 March, names him as one of those "consenting to the death of David and now in displeasure with the Queen and their houses taken and spoiled." On 8 June he was denounced as a rebel; it is likely that he was at Carberry Hill, but in any case the result restored his position. Five years later he is recorded in Calderwood as interfering to secure the safety

of John Knox; there can be little doubt that he was a Protestant of deep conviction and of long standing. Until 1584 his name periodically appears in the records of Assembly and Parliament, but thereafter he took little part in public life. His testament was lodged on 24 May 1595. His second wife, Janet Melville, survived him and died in September 1603. He had seven children, James, who quarreled with his father and was disinherited, Patric, John, who married Elizabeth Halden and died in 1607, Johanna, who married William Bonar of Rossic in 1576, Margaret, who married Alexander Crichton of Drylaw and Naughton in 1580, Marion, who married the Laird of Coekburn, and Martha, who died single.

Patrick Johnstone succeeded his father, took no part in public life, married Elizabeth Dundas, who survived him until March 1615, and had five children, Robert, Patrick, Martha, and Mary, all of whom died young, and Barbara, who survived him unmarried and to whom he left 7,000 merks. His testament was lodged on 27 April 1607.

Of the other children of Sir Andrew Johnstone—for he had been knighted before 1553—two, John and Adam, are of some interest. Adam, the third son, matriculated at St. Andrews in 1552 and graduated in 1555, and later became minister of Crichton and provost of the collegiate church. He followed the outlook of his father in adhering to the more radical wing of the Kirk and was in prison in 1584 for failing to subscribe obedience to his ordinary, the Bishop. When he died in 1595, survived by his wife Agnes Borthwick, his books were valued at £100 and his household appointments at 100 merks. His "frie gear" amounted to £6,102-13-4. Robert, another son of Sir Andrew, became a merchant in Edinburgh, Gilbert died young, Mariota married David Hume of Wedderburn, and Elizabeth married Sir William Cranstoun of Cranstoun.

Sir Andrew's second son, John, is frequently named in the records as "John Johnstone of Elphinstone," possibly to distinguish him from a namesake who for a time was clerk to the Privy Council but possibly because he was the younger twin of James. A lawyer in Edinburgh, he was active in the Kirk and in educational matters. An intimate friend of Knox, he was a witness to his will and is described as visiting him when he was on his deathbed in 1573. In 1600 he bought Langraw in Fife but his home continued to be in Stewart's Close on the south side of the High Street of Edinburgh. His death took place between November 1607 and September 1608. By his wife, Isobel Barron, he had five children; Robert, who died early, Samuel, Patrick, Janet, and Barbara, who married John Ker, minister of Prestonpans. By his will, dated at Prestonpans,

31 October 1607, he left £696-13-4, but he had also the very large sum of £17,202-3-8 owing to him. One surmises that he had added money lending to his legal activities. Clearly, he had prospered. Though briefly recorded here, he had been a man of importance among the Reformed supporters.

With the death of Patrick Johnstone, since he left no male heir, the Elphinstone lands passed to Samuel Johnstone, the second and eldest surviving son of John Johnstone. It was to be his fate to spend most of the fortune which his father had accumulated. In the autumn of 1612 he received licence from the crown to travel abroad in parts beyond the sea for the space of five years, and not until 1620 is he again on record in Scotland.

Of all the Scottish coalfields, Tranent is the oldest so far as documentary evidence goes. Three coalpots—Bankton, Birsley, and Elphinstone—survive in the parish today from mediaeval times, though partly obscured by later deposits. In these not only the Tranent Great Scam of Coal was worked, but also the sandstone, limestone, and blue clay which lay next to the coal. It was from this blue clay that the familiar red tiles were made for the roofing of East Lothian cottages. The Johnstones' coalpot may still be examined at Elphinstone, but by the time of Samuel Johnstone the workings stretched far underground towards Fawside.

In April 1620 Samuel Johnstone appealed to the Privy Council for what amounted to a patent on new devices which he had invented for coalworking. Simultaneously he made arrangements with the neighbouring coalmasters to raise prices to consumers. When charged before the Privy Council he and his associates defended themselves on the ground that their losses were heavy. Even so, Samuel Johnstone was wealthy enough in 1624 to recover the lands of Leuchie from his younger brother Patrick in return for the settling of his debts to the amount of £8,085. In 1624 he became Sheriff of Haddington and on 18 October 1627 he received a grant of land in Nova Scotia and became a baronet. Between 1628 and 1632 he is recorded as engaged in the prosecution of a large number of local witches. At least 25 came before him. One relie of Sir Samuel remains in his medal attached to the Musselburgh Arrow which he won, together with 30/- and a dozen bottles of claret, in 1603.

He died on 18 February 1637, survived by his wife, Jean Douglas of Spott, leaving a son, John, and daughters, Elizabeth, Jean, Helen, Mary, and Anna. Elizabeth married John Seton in 1663 and, after his death, Lord Johnstone, later Earl of Hartfell, in 1643. Sir Samuel had been spendthrift. Of the fortune

left by his father only a fraction remained, for Sir Samuel left £2,878 but also owed £516-12-0.

Sir John, the second baronet, succeeded his father in the title, the lands, and the coal business. No more successful in business than his father, he was obliged to sell to the Setons the lands of Wolfstar, which had been purchased from them at one time. Leuchie at North Berwick was also sold. In February 1652 Sir John was one of the few men of family in East Lothian to sign the assent of the heritors to the Cromwellian proposals for a Union between Scotland and England, so it would appear that he held the same views as his grandfather and great-grandfather. Sir John's testament was lodged on 14 January, 1664. By his wife, Margaret Keith, daughter of James Keith of Benholme and cousin of the Earl of Marischal, he had a son, James, and a daughter Margaret, who on 25 October 1664 married James, second son of Alexander Borthwick of Glencorse.

Sir James Johnstone, third baronet of Elphinstone, inherited an estate already bankrupt, for his father had received large loans from his brother-in-law, Sir Archibald Primrose of Carrington. On 12 September 1664 Sir James executed a bond of provision in favour of his children, Margaret, Jean, Elizabeth, John, and Anna, but by assignations dated June 1666 and 23 July 1674 Margaret, Jean, and Anna resigned their portions to Sir Archibald Primrose. On 10 April 1666 Sir James, hopelessly bankrupt, transferred the family lands to Sir Archibald Primrose in settlement of his debts. For a time he farmed in New Monkland parish but later he returned to Edinburgh, where Sir John Foulis of Ravelston notes that he had supper with him in 1705. He died in 1727 and was buried in Greyfriars Kirkyard, with four cornerstones to mark his grave. It is possible that a claimant to the baronetcy may still survive through his son, John, who had disappeared into poverty.

#### THE SCOTTISH GENEALOGY SOCIETY

At a General Meeting of the Scottish Genealogy Society, the following Constitution was adopted on Saturday, 4th July, 1953:—

1. The objects of the Scottish Genealogy Society are:—

To promote research into Scottish Family History.

To underake the collection, exchange and publication of information and material relating to Scottish Genealogy, by means of meetings, lectures, etc., etc.

- 2. The Society will consist of all duly elected Members whose subscriptions are paid. A President and one or more Vice-Presidents may be elected at the Annual General Meeting.
- 3. The affairs of the Society shall be managed by a Council consisting of Chairman, Honorary Secretary, Honorary Treasurer, Honorary Editor, Honorary Librarian, and not more than twelve other Members. A non-Council Member of the Society shall be appointed to audit the accounts annually.
- 4. Office-Bearers shall be elected annually. Four Ordinary Members of Council shall retire annually in rotation, but shall be eligible for re-election. At meetings of the Council, a quorum shall consist of not less than one-third of the members.
- 5. An Annual General Meeting of the Society will be held at or about the end of October, on a date to be determined by the Council, at which reports will be submitted.
  - 6. Members shall receive one copy of each issue of The Scottish Genealogist, but these shall not be supplied to any Members who are in arrears.
  - 7. No alteration of this Constitution shall be made except at the Annual General Meeting of the Society, when a two-thirds majority will be required.
